


Managing OG Static Sites

Updates and deployments are slow and very manual; while Webmasters can become process bottlenecks, we are reluctant to grant FTP access to the rest of the org.




Homebrewed Solutions

With colorful dashboards and icons, these early interfaces put content administration only a few clicks away -- but created new challenges in process and scaling.




Open Source CMS Solutions

Desire for collaboration and fresh, relevant content required feature rich platforms that could be updated daily. Open source frameworks produce quality sites faster.




Getting a Little Graphic *The rise of GUIs and no-code tools in web development.*

We have to adapt, because other software is pushing the envelope. Making it easy (and even fun) to build web apps.




Layout Builder

Spectacular Views I can see my content model from up here.


Ways we can all benefit from using Views

- **Feature Rich**: As a mature project, Views has many bells and whistles out of the box.
- **Extensible**: Many compatible modules to introduce new features to Views.
- Accessible: No-code required to get started. Plenty of training materials
- **Consistent**: Exported configs stored in a predictable/portable set of yaml files.
- **Supported**: Limits future technical debt.




Reasons developer may avoid using Views

- **Control**: We like (need) to reinvent the wheel. Creating the perfect tool for the job.
- **Clarity**: Big Views can be overwhelming. We can comment and organize our custom code.
- Not Powerful Enough: Custom requests push the limits of what is possible in Views.



Task: Create Collections

- Action and Adventure Movies WHERE category IN ('action', 'adventure')
- Family Comedies WHERE category = 'comedy' AND category = 'family'
- Happy Holidays WHERE keyword = 'holidays' and category <> 'horror'
- Now Trending WHERE popularity > '8' ORDER BY popularity DESC
- Cult Classics WHERE critics_rating < '2' AND users_rating > '8'
- Box Office Bombs movies, (revenue - budget) as profit WHERE profit < '0' ORDER BY profit ASC

Allowing users to create views may be scary; but with a little work we can offer access. Your strategy may include:


- Defining new **permissions** and roles
