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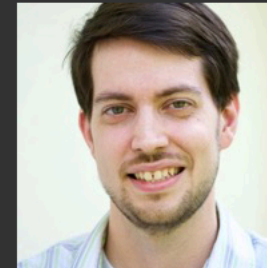


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# Migration Goals

- Preserve all URLs, redirects, SEO optimizations
- Be able to reinstall site at any point during the migration
- Use modern goodies like:
  - GitHub Actions for CI
  - Composer

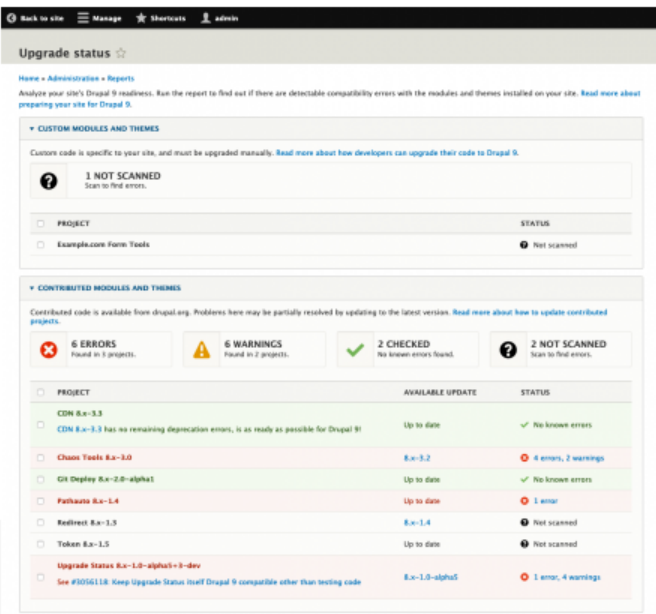
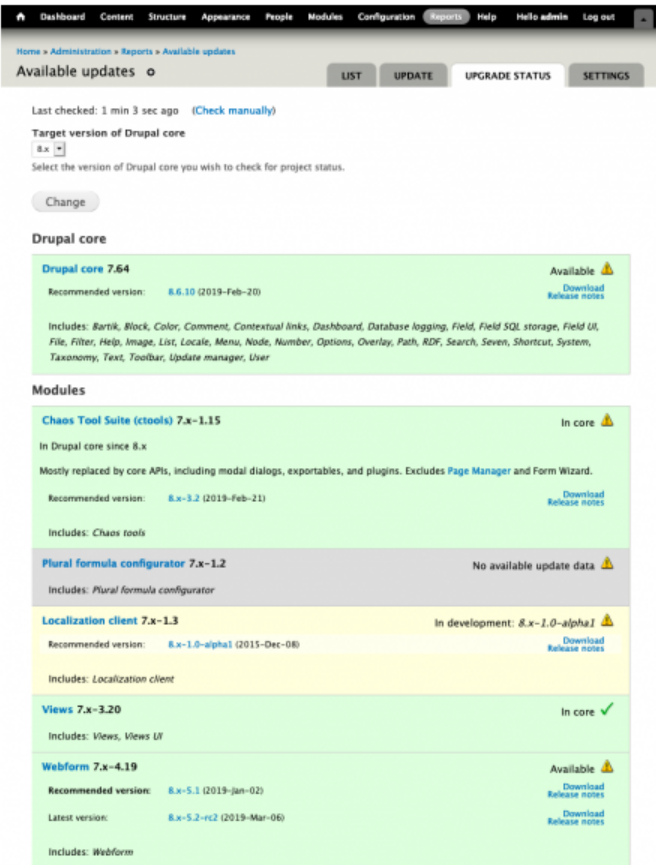
### Drupal 8 and later

This module scans the code of the contributed and custom projects you have installed, and reports on any deprecated code that must be replaced before the next major version. Available project updates are also suggested to keep your site up to date as project will resolve deprecation errors over time.

Due to third party PHP library dependencies, the module needs to be [installed with Composer](#).

```
$ composer install --dev
$ composer require 'drupal/upgrade_status:^2.0'
```

If you have an existing Drupal 8 site that does not use Composer, [this may be a good time to make the move](#). Composer is a tool to download and manage the different dependencies a Drupal site has, making sure that all their requirements are met.

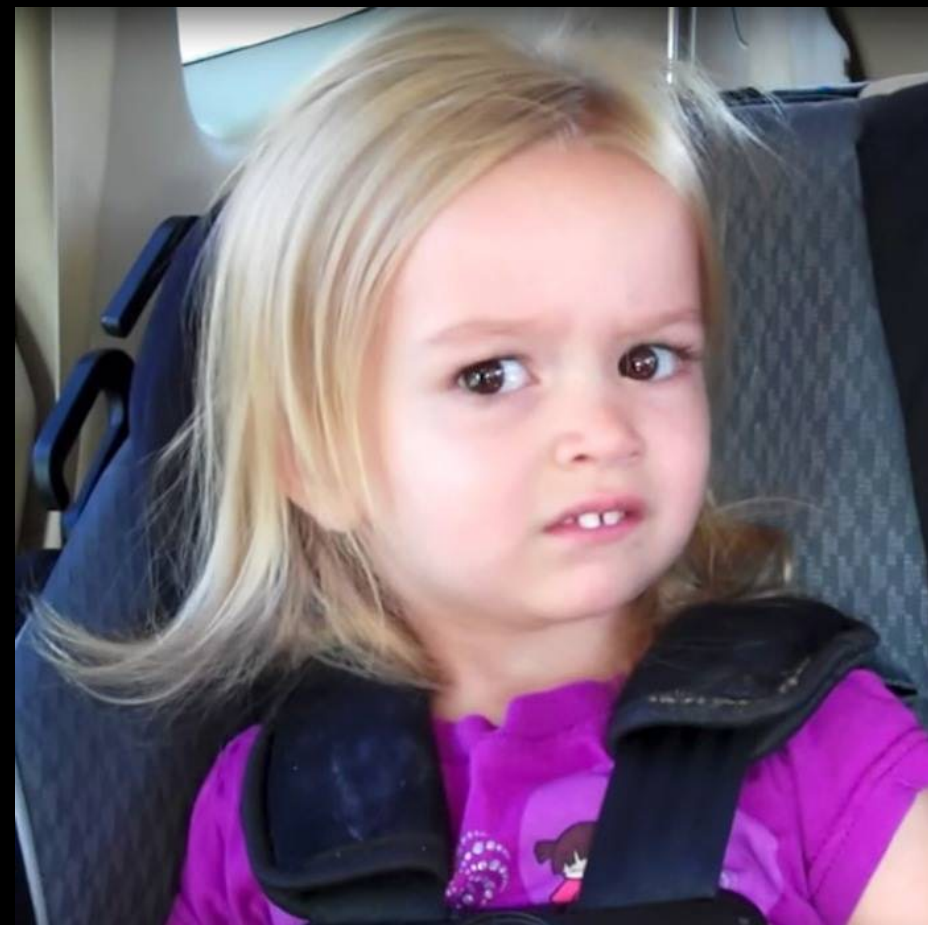
